School Closure in the Event of Heavy Snowfall

If you are not registered and wish to do so, please contact the main school office who will be able to advise you on how to register. A message will also be put on the school website. We will also endeavour to get the announcement read out on the local radio stations too so please ensure that you also listen to those (Radio Nottingham and Capital FM). The Nottinghamshire County Council website will also list school closures. At times we have closed during the day due to the need for parents to be able to collect children safely. Often the snow is worse in Ravenshead than where parents are working. Please ensure therefore that your contact details are up to date. If you wish another parent to collect your child please could you notify the office.
