Our Christian value for this term is: Wisdom

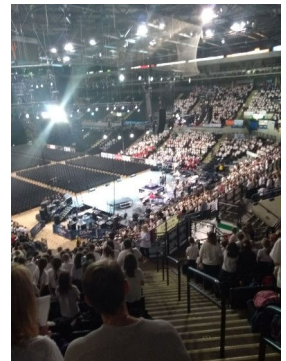
This half term's Christian Value is 'Wisdom'

There is a type of literature in the Bible that is sometimes called 'Wisdom Literature' and an important idea in these writings is that 'the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom'. Wisdom is insight into the way life works: a proper understanding of the consequences of our thoughts, words and actions and an awareness of the true value of things. It is rooted in proper reverence for God who is the source of all life and all values.

Although related to education and knowledge, wisdom differs from cleverness. Wisdom may be best described as discernment gained through life experience and distilled into guiding principles. Sometimes, the word is used in the Bible to refer to the practical and technical skills possessed by an experienced craftsman or administrator. In the book of Proverbs, Wisdom is sometimes personified and, at one point, is spoken of as she who worked alongside God as a master craftsman when God created the world.

Choir performance at Young Voices

On Monday 23 members of the choir performed at the Young Voices concert at Sheffield arena. In total 5628 children sang a collection of songs which included ones that were sang with up and coming artists. It was a fantastic day and a wonderful show!
