### Cook's Corner from Charlotte

It's the final week before half-term - This week we are on Week 2 menu, with one of the favourites from Parent's Evening - Chocolate Brownie. When we return from the holidays, winter will be finally here, with the clocks changing while we are off. Here is a quick Toffee Apple recipe for a Bonfire Night treat, or a nibble for those cosy evenings in:

*Wash 6 small apples in hot water to remove the waxy coating, so the toffee will stick. Push sharpened strong wooden sticks into each one. Make the toffee by gently melting 300g caster sugar in a heavy pan until melted. Cook over a high heat until it caramelises to a golden brown. Dip the pan in cold water to stop cooking. Quickly dip each apple in the hot toffee and place on a baking tray, lined with baking parchment to cool.*
