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Transition Years 1-6 (for September 2017) and Parent's Open Afternoon 4th/5th July

The children will be told their new classes on Monday 3rd July and this will be sent out by Parentmail on the same day. Please may I remind you that the governors have agreed a class setting policy for the school which can be found on the school website. The children will move into their new classes on Tuesday 4th and Wednesday 5th July.

On the Tuesday, your child will need to go to their current class, where they will be registered, before being taken to their new teacher and classroom. They will spend the whole day in that class and will be dismissed from their new classroom. Therefore, you will need to collect your child from their new cloakroom door.

On the Wednesday, your child will need to go to their new

cloakroom_entry door so that they can become familiar with where they will need to go in September. The children will stay in their new class for the whole day and there will be the opportunity for parents to visit their children in their new classes during the afternoon as part of our **Open Afternoon**. This will begin at **1.15pm** (which will give teachers the chance to bring the children in from lunch and register them) and will finish at **3.20pm** (when parents will be asked to then go outside onto the playground to allow teachers to prepare children for the end of the day and to dismiss them safely). Parents do not need to stay for the whole session and may come at any time within that period.

Foundation

Foundation 2's transition day will be the Tuesday from 9.30-3pm (unless they attend the F1 session on a Tuesday and then they will come and go at the normal time). Parents are more than welcome to come in but they will not find out their teacher until the end of that day as there will be some new children coming into the school (from other settings) that will need to be allocated.

Year 6

The children will go to Joseph Whitaker on **Tuesday and Wednesday** and buses will collect and bring them back to school. Please ensure that the children are at school in time for the buses leaving at **8.45 am**.

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Latest News re 30 hours Early Years Entitlement for 3 year olds

Register for up to 30 hours free entitlement by **21st July** for a September 2017 start.

The school is now taking children into the **F1 preschool** a term earlier i.e. the term **immediately** after their third birthday. Please see the table below:-

Born between	Start date for pre-school 15-30 hours free childcare
1st April and 31st August	September (Autumn term)
1st September and 31st December	January (Spring term)
1st January—31st March	April (Summer term)

All parents are eligible 15 hours free entitlement from the term after their third birthday and you may now be eligible to up to 30 hours . Please see the link below to see if you can claim.

If you are eligible for the extra hours you will need to bring your eligibility code into school by the end of term, **21st July**. This is so school can validate it for a September start.

Parents may take the extended entitlement with up to two/three providers.

Please contact the school if you need any support with the application or to discuss availability of sessions for your child.
