Cook's Corner from Charlotte

Sweet Smorgasbord Recipe

150g Butter, 300g Plain Flour, 1tsp Bicarbonate of Soda, 1/2tsp Sea Salt Flakes, 150g Soft Brown Sugar, 100g Caster Sugar, 1 Egg, 1 Egg Yolk, 3tbsp Milk, 2tbsp Ground Cinnamon, 1tsp Ground Ginger, 1/2tsp Ground Cloves, 1/2tsp Ground Cardamon, 1/2tsp Vanilla Sugar.

Pre heat oven to 175C/350F or gas mark 4

- 1. Melt the butter and set aside to cool. Combine flour, bicarb, salt and spice mix in a bowl the set aside.
- 2. Combing sugars with butter. Stir until no lumps.
- 3. Add milk, egg and egg yolk mix until thoroughly combined.
- 4. Add flour and spice mixture.
- 5. Chill for a few hours.
- 6. line baking trays with parchment.
- 7. Make rough dough balls the size of golf balls, place on tray about 5cm
- 8. Bake in the oven for 8 to 10 minutes or until just golden.

Delicious!! A great breakfast treat.
